



Effective February 1, 2017, the Library will install filtering software on all public computers; the Library filtered staff computers several months ago. This software will block direct access to images and videos that depict pornography, child pornography, or obscenity.

Accessing pornography, child pornography, and/or other obscenity online in a public place is inconsistent with the welcoming and comfortable environment that we seek to provide everyone at the Library. Also, to be eligible for federal funds to maintain fast and durable Internet connectivity for our patrons and visitors, federal law requires that public libraries adopt and enforce reasonable policies of Internet safety that are consistent with the federal "Children's Internet Protection Act," as amended.

Objectionable images and videos brought in by e-mail, social media, or USB device remain prohibited according to current policy.
