



Harlem Hellfighters by Max Brooks. This is a riveting story of a highly decorated barrier-breaking historic black regiment. In 1919 the 369th infantry regiment marched home triumphantly from World War I. They spent more time in combat than any other U.S. unit never losing a foot of ground to the enemy or a man to capture and winning countless decorations. Though they returned as heroes this African American unit faced discrimination from their own government. The Harlem Hellfighters as the Germans called them fought courageously to make Europe and America safe for democracy. YA BRO
