All articles must have labels attached to the back upper left corner with the artist's name, contact information, media type and date of piece. Sculptures may be accepted on a case-by-case basis.

In addition to this form, please also send the following materials:

- Up to 6 digital images (JPG or PNG, preferably at least 800 x 600 pixels and/or 1 MB, of work you plan to show. Be sure to indicate the title, size and media for each piece. Alternatively, you can snail-mail or hand-deliver these images on a CD or flashdrive, or bring originals for a review, by appointment only.
- Brief artist's bio/statement (3 - 4 sentences about you and your work).
