

# Accessing your COVID Vaccination Record

## ELECTRONIC RECORDS - CTWIZ

If you were vaccinated in Connecticut, you can access your records on CTWiz, the state vaccination record database

### ACCESSING YOUR RECORD IN CTWIZ



1. Scan the QR code to visit the CTWiz website
2. Enter First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, and Gender
3. Enter a phone number or email for two-factor authentication  
\*\*\*NOTE: Enter the same phone number or email that you provided when registering for your vaccination.
4. Click "Search"
5. Click "Request Code to Access Immunization Record"
6. Enter the code you were sent and click "Verify"
7. At the top of the page, select "Download COVID-19 Record"

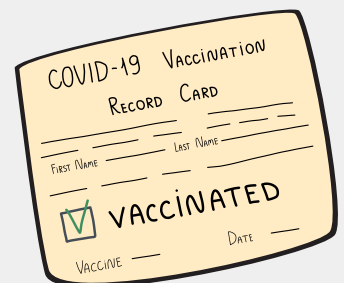

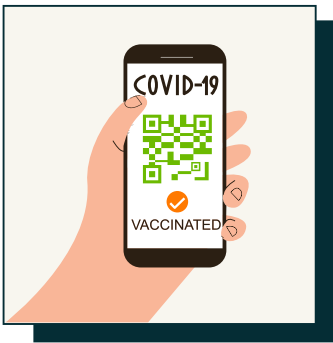

# SMART Health Cards

Store your vaccination record on your mobile device with your SMART health card to have keep proof of vaccination on you at all times!

## ANDROID DEVICES



CommonHealth App

1. Download COVID-19 record from CTWiz (see reverse side for instructions)
2. Download CommonHealth app from Google Play
3. Create a passcode in CommonHealth
4. Use the CommonHealth app to scan SMART Health QR Code on your CTWiz COVID-19 vaccination record
5. View your record and QR code in the CommonHealth app

## APPLE DEVICES WITH IOS 15.1

1. Download COVID-19 record from CTWiz (see reverse side for instructions)
2. Use your phone camera to scan the SMART Health QR Code on your CTWiz COVID-19 vaccination record
3. Click "Add to Wallet and Health"
4. View your record and QR code in Apple Wallet



## OLDER APPLE DEVICES (WITH IOS 13.2 OR ABOVE)



CommonPass App

1. Download COVID-19 record from CTWiz
2. Download CommonPass app from the App Store
3. Create a passcode
4. Use the CommonPass app to scan SMART Health QR Code on your CTWiz COVID-19 vaccination record
5. View your record and QR code in the CommonPass app

\*\*\*Note: Booster shots will not appear in CommonPass app; CommonPass is different from the CommonHealth app for android users
