President's Report

- Introduction of guest, volunteer book sorter Christina Trier.
- Annual Meeting planning: the date is confirmed for June 10th, at 4:30-5:30, in the Hubbard Room.
 - This year is an election year, and all current officers have indicated that they will continue in their respective roles.
 - Both email and 'snail mail' invitations to be sent out shortly. Follow up email will go out two
 weeks prior to the meeting, with last year's minutes and the agenda, as well as a reminder two
 days ahead of the meeting.

- Responses from the Volunteer Appreciation Day table in the lobby: there were not very many patrons
 coming through the lobby, even with a music and dance event that was taking place. The volunteers
 handed out brochures and attempted to engage people in talking about the Friends and what we do.
 There were two new memberships (in cash), and one new volunteer sorter. In future, we need better
 table signage vertical sign holder display, and a banner.
- More ways to increase awareness of the Friends role: signs and brochures at library events, with more frequent headlines and acknowledgement footnotes in program announcements in the library's newsletter.

Treasurer's Report

- Excellent continuing income from the Book Nook.
- Income is on track to match, and likely exceed, last year's, with one more Book Sale next month.

Discussion and new business

- Ramona's father has passed away, and she will be out of the office for a short time. The Friends will send a sympathy card to her home.
- The Hitchcock Room is to be sub-divided, with more space given to the maintenance staff. The layout has not been finalized, so the Friends are not yet able to plan how to rearrange the tables, desks, and bookcases.
- Discussion of a social event in September, when more people are likely to attend.
- Continuing discussion of changing the time of the Executive Committee meetings, holding some outside of regular office hours, perhaps on Thursdays at 4:30.
- Continuing discussion of membership: rates, and whether volunteers should be given membership.
